WITH THE DRAW AVAILABLE ONE WEEK PRIOR VIA THE
EVENTS SECTION OF THE WEBSITE

ENTRY FEES ARE NON REFUNDABLE AFTER ENTRIES
CLOSE. IF ANY EVENT IS CANCELLED DUE TO ADVERSE
WEATHER CONDITIONS, OR ANY OTHER VALID
REASON, THE ENTRY FEES WILL AUTOMATICALLY
TRANSFER TO A RESCHEDULED DATE

COMPETITORS WHO CANT COMPETE DUE TO COVID
19 RESTRICTIONS CAN TRANSFER THEIR ENTRY TO

PRIZES & TOUR LEADERBOARD POINTS WILL BE PRESENTED AT EACH EVENT. THE OVERALL ORDER OF MERIT POINTS LEADER AT THE END OF EACH TOUR WILL RECEIVE A TAKE HOME TROPHY AND PRIZE, ALONG WITH BEING CROWNED THE OVERALL TOUR CHAMPION

THE OVERALL POINTS LEADER IN EACH AGE CATEGORY WILL ALSO RECEIVE A TAKE HOME TROPHY AND BE INVITED TO COMPETE IN THE TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

2021 QUALIFYING CRITERIA

THE OVERALL BOYS & GIRLS GROSS CHAMPIONS IN THE UNDER 9 CATEGORIES WILL BE INVITED TO COMPETE

THE OVERALL BOYS & GIRLS GROSS & NETT CHAMPIONS IN THE UNDER 18 CATEGORIES WILL BE INVITED TO COMPETE

IF A COMPETITOR HAS PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED THE NEXT COMPETITOR IN LINE WILL GAIN QUALIFICATION

FOR A BOYS OR GIRLS CATEGORY TO BE INCLUDED IN THE QUALIFICATION PROCESS THERE MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 6 PLAYERS COMPETING. THIS WILL BE REVIEWED IF THERE IS CONSTANTLY LESS THAN 6 IN A CATEGORY.

COMPETITOR NUMBERS IN THE 'CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS' IS STRICTLY LIMITED WITH COMPETITORS FROM OVER 30 COUNTRIES WORLDWIDE DUE TO TAKE PART DEPENDING ON GOVERNMENT GUIDELINES

RULES & REGULATIONS

FORMAT: EACH PLAYER WILL PLAY THEIR DESIGNATED HOLES, MARKING THEIR SCORECARD AS STROKE PLAY.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: DEVICES THAT MEASURE DISTANCES ARE PERMITTED.

CADDIES: NO CADDIES ARE ALLOWED FOR COMPETITORS AGED 13 OR OVER. ANY COMPETITOR 12 OR UNDER CAN HAVE A CADDY BUT THERE IS STRICTLY NO COACHING, ADVISE, OR YARDAGES TO BE GIVEN. ALL A CADDY CAN DO IS CARRY OR PUSH THE CLUBS. FAILURE TO ADHERE TO THIS WILL RESULT IN A 2 SHOT PENALTY FOR EACH BREACH. THIS HAS BEEN PUT IN PLAY TO HELP THE SPEED OF PLAY.

PACE OF PLAY: EACH PLAYER MUST PLAY WITHOUT UNDUE DELAY, WHICH IS DEFINED AS TAKING NO MORE THAN 45 SECONDS TO PLAY A SHOT. WHEN IT IS DETERMINED THAT A GROUP IS BEHIND TIME, OR OUT OF POSITION ON THE GOLF COURSE THE GROUP WILL BE WARNED AND ASKED TO SPEED UP PLAY. IF THE GROUP CONTINUES TO FALL BEHIND EACH MEMBER OF THE GROUP MAY BE TIMED. IF A PLAYER TAKES MORE THAN THE ALLOCATED TIME, HE OR SHE MAY BE SUBJECT TO A PENALTY. FIRST OFFENSE, WARNING; SECOND OFFENSE; ONE STROKE PENALTY; SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES; DISQUALIFICATION.

DUE TO EXCEPTIONALLY SLOW PLAY IN THE PAST WE ARE PUTTING IN PLACE THE FOLLOWING TIME LIMITS FOR ALL OUR EVENTS,

18 HOLES - 4 HOURS 30 MINUTES

9 HOLES - 2 HOURS 15 MINUTES

THE FIRST GROUP TO COME IN OVER THESE TIME LIMITS WILL BE PENALISED 1 SHOT FOR EVERY 10 MINUTES OVER THIS TIME. THE TIME LIMIT WILL BE REVIEWED IN EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, ESPECIALLY IF ONLY ONE COMPETITOR IS HOLDING PLAY UP.

CODE OF CONDUCT: VIOLATIONS INCLUDE - ABUSIVE LANGUAGE, CLUB THROWING, CHEATING, DISRESPECT OF VOLUNTEERS OR OFFICIALS, ABUSE TO THE GOLF COURSE OR THE FACILITIES, LITTERING, OR ANY OTHER CONDUCT UNBECOMING OF A PLAYER. THE CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISMISS ANY PLAYER, CADDIE OR SPECTATOR AT ANY TIME DURING THE EVENT.

RESULT OF THE COMPETITION: WHEN ALL THE SCORES HAVE BEEN POSTED ON THE OFFICIAL SCOREBOARD AND APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE, THE RESULT OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP IS DEEMED TO HAVE BEEN OFFICIALLY ANNOUNCED UNLESS DUE TO A RULES VIOLATION OR GENUINE MISTAKE.

HOW TO DECIDE TIES: TIES FOR ALL PRIZES WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE BEST SCORE ON THE FINAL 9, 6, 3, 2 AND 1 HOLES OR LAST 6, 3, 2 AND 1 HOLES FOR THE UNDER 9 CHAMPIONSHIPS. IF THERE IS A TIE IN THE OVERALL LEADERBOARDS, THE COMPETITOR WITH THE MOST POINTS AT THE FINAL EVENT WILL BE DEEMED THE CHAMPION, IF THERE IS A TIE ON THIS SCORE IT WILL RESORT TO THE 2ND LAST EVENT AND SO ON.

SIGNAL FOR SUSPENSION AND RESUMPTION OF PLAY (LIGHTING): IF PLAY IS TO BE SUSPENDED, ONE LONG SIRON OR HORN BLAST WILL SUSPEND PLAY. PLEASE TAKE SHELTER OR COME OFF THE GOLF COURSE. TWO LONG SIRON WILL RECOMMENCE PLAY.

SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENT: PARTICIPATION DURING TOURNAMENT PLAY CAN BE DANGEROUS. A PLAYER MAY DISCONTINUE PLAY IF HE/SHE BELIEVES THERE ARE DANGEROUS WEATHER CONDITIONS (LIGHTNING, ETC) OR OTHER GOOD REASON SUCH AS ILLNESS. SEEK SHELTER OR MEDICAL HELP WHEN THESE CONDITIONS ARISE.

HANDICAP MAXIMUMS : BOYS 28 GIRLS 36
COMPETITORS WITH HIGHER HANDICAPS CAN PLAY BUT MUST PLAY OF THE MAXIMUMS ABOVE

PLEASE BE AWARE OF OTHERS NEAR YOU AT ALL TIMES ON THE GOLF COURSE AND PRACTICE AREA. IT IS POSSIBLE THAT YOU MAY GET STRUCK BY A CLUB OR BALL HIT BY SOMEONE ELSE. WHEN RIDING IN A GOLF CART, PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THE MANUFACTURERS SAFETY NOTICES AT ALL TIMES. RIDING IN A CART OR BEING STRUCK WITH A CLUB OR BALL CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH. ALL COMPETITORS, CADDIES AND SPECTATORS VENTURE ONTO THE GOLF FACILITIES AT THEIR OWN RISK. THE IRISH JUNIOR OPEN IS NOT LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTS OR ACCIDENTS WHILST AT OUR EVENTS.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER ENTRIES HAVE CLOSED. REFUND REQUESTS PRIOR TO ENTRIES CLOSING WILL BE SUBJECT TO A 10% ADMINISTRATION FEE. IN THE EVENT OF WEATHER CAUSING A DELAY TO OUR CHAMPIONSHIPS, THE PRIZE WINNERS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE LEAST AMOUNT OF HOLES ANY COMPETITOR HAS PLAYED IN THEIR RESPECTED AGE CHAMPIONSHIP PROVIDED ALL THE FIELD IN THAT AGE GROUP HAS PLAYED A MINIMUM OF 9 HOLES OR 6 HOLES FOR THE UNDER 9'S. IF THERE IS A TIE ON THESE SCORES THE FINAL 3, 2 OR 1 HOLES WILL DECIDE THE CHAMPION

THE IRISH JUNIOR OPEN COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CHANGE THE RULES & REGULATIONS PRIOR TO, OR DURING THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.

ALL COMPETITORS PLAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LATEST RULES OF GOLF AND THE LOCAL RULES.
